## How to find Avondale

Our offices at Chapter House are strategically located in the historic and prestigious town of Reigate in Surrey, with immediate access to the national motorway network, mainline rail, Gatwick Airport (7miles) and Heathrow Airport (35miles)

### FROM M25

- Exit at Junction 8 (Reigate) and take the A217 towards Reigate.
- Proceed down Reigate Hill, across the level crossing and into the one way system, bearing right.
- Continue through the high street and at the end bear right into London Road, direction back to M25.
- Our offices are located on the left hand side just after the road splits to the right back into the one way system.

### FROM GATWICK

- From Gatwick, follow the A23 signposted Redhill. Then follow the A217 signposted to Reigate and the M25 for approx. 6 miles.
- At the traffic lights in Woodhatch by The Angel pub continue up Cockshot Hill on the A217 to Reigate. Once you reach the brow of the hill you are in Reigate.
- Continue straight on into the town centre, following onto the one-way system at Reigate clock-tower. This is the High Street; at the second set of traffic lights, turn right, signposted M25. This is London Road.
- Our offices are located on the left hand side just after the road splits to the right back into the one way system.

### BY TRAIN

- Redhill Station is on the main London - Brighton Line and is 1.5 miles from the office.
- Reigate Station is 2 minutes walk away.
- Trains run nearly every half hour to both stations.

### VISITORS PARKING

- Visitor's parking is marked Avondale and is at the front and rear of the building. Please let us know how many parking spaces you need to be reserved for your visit to Avondale.
